

# Obligated Projects in FY 2012 Utilizing Federal Funds

## Federal Funds Awarded During the 2012 Fiscal Year

### **What is the Richland County Regional Planning Commission MPO?**

Federal Law (134, 23 U.S.C) requires that areas with a population of 50,000 or more establish a Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO). Funded by the Highway Trust Fund, the MPO represent local, regional, and national interests in the transportation planning process. Nationwide there are 385 MPO's that represent 84% of the nation's population, 90% of the GDP, and produce 85% of the exports. This number is projected to increase over the next 20 years to 94% of America's economic growth. In Ohio the metropolitan areas represent 87% of the GDP.

### **What does the Richland County Regional Planning Commission MPO do?**

Specifically, Federal Law requires the MPO to address the following 8 factors during the transportation planning process:

- Support the economic vitality of the area, enabling global competitiveness, productivity, and efficiency
- Increase safety for users
- Increase security for users
- Increase accessibility and mobility for people and freight
- Protect and enhance environment and quality of life
- Enhance connectivity across modes for people and freight
- Promote efficient system management and operation
- Emphasize preservation of existing system

### **What Is the Listing Annual Obligated federal Funds for Projects?**

The listing of obligated projects is required by federal law. The MPO on a 2-year cycle develops a Transportation Improvement Program that utilizes federal funds through their transportation planning process. This process is also referred to as the 3 (C) process, which is a Continuing, Cooperative and Comprehensive Planning process with local, state, and federal officials.
