OF THE COORDINATING COMMITTEE OF THE CONTINUING COMPREHENSIVE LAND-USE AND TRANSPORTATION PROGRAM FOR RICHLAND COUNTY, OHIO

A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE FY 2008 - 2011 TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (TIP)

WHEREAS, the Coordinating Committee of the Continuing Comprehensive Land-Use and Transportation Program of the Richland County Regional Planning Commission who is designated as the Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) for the Mansfield urbanized area by the Governor acting through the Ohio Department of Transportation in cooperation with locally elected officials of Richland County; and

WHEREAS, the Richland County Regional Planning Commission is designated as the Metropolitan Clearinghouse for Richland County; and

WHEREAS, the MPO, pursuant to 23 U.S.C.134/49 U.S.C. 5303(j)(1)(D) and 23 U.S.C. 135/49 U.S.C. 5304(g)(1) developed and approved on May 23, 2007, a four-year multi-modal Transportation Improvement Program (TIP); and

WHEREAS, the MPO has prepared and approved a Transportation Improvement Program for Fiscal Years 2008 – 2011 and found the projects consistent with the approved 2030 Long Range Transportation Plan for the Mansfield/Richland County Urban Area; and

WHEREAS, the Richland County Engineer requested a amendment to the 2008 – 2011 Transportation Improvement Program to include the following nine (9) Highway Maintenance Projects for a total project cost of \$1,794,722 of which \$1,418,578 will be funded by Federal Surface Transportation Funds:
